#### X. We Should Care More About Love and Less About Sex

#### Attacking the Sexual Ethic of Scripture

#### A. Progressive

- When it comes to sex in general or sexual orientation specifically, it's important to demonstrate understanding and affirmation rather than passing judgment
- 2. Justifying Sexual Sin (5 steps)
  - a) Teach the moral virtues of those who are in sexual sin
  - b) Insist that God has "bigger" things to concern Himself with
  - c) Show the disputed sexual behavior leads to positive results (overall)
  - d) Portray those who stand against such behavior as narrow cold harsh unsympathetic, etc.
  - e) Insist that Jesus is on your side (i.e. . . .)
    - (1) Woman caught in adultery
    - (2) Woman at the well
    - (3) Tax collectors and sinners

## B. Biblical Perspective

- 1. God defines love and gives the context for sex . . .
  - a) Genesis 1:28, 2:18, 23-24
  - b) 1 Corinthians 7:32-34
  - c) Hebrews 13:4
- 2. Prohibition against the misuse of sex
  - a) Leviticus 18:6-23
  - b) 1 Corinthians 6:12-20
- 3. This is the standard and it does not change

# XI. <u>Life in This World is More Important Than the Life to Come</u>

Minimize the Afterlife

## A. <u>Progressive</u>

- 1. Do not deny the afterlife, but put the stress on this life
- 2. Functionally, they are Universilists (many)
- 3. Many deny that a literal Hell exists (Hell on earth)

  - a) John 3:17-18
  - b) 2 Thessalonians 1:7b-8
  - c) Revelation 21:6-8
